Cost and Accommodation:

Visa Process:

- Acceptance Letter:

Obtain an acceptance letter from the university.

- Prepare Documents:

Gather required documents, including completed visa application form, valid passport, proof of financial support, health insurance certificate, academic transcripts and certificates etc.

- Apply for MOFA Approval:

Submit your application to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) through your university, ensuring all documents are verified before proceeding to the embassy.

- Submit Visa Application and Attend Interview: After obtaining MOFA approval, apply for a student visa (D-2 or D-4) at the South Korean embassy or in Pakistan. Participate in an interview and provide any additional documents if requested.

- Visa Approval and Receive Visa:

Monitor the application status and collect your visa once approved, ensuring all details are correct. Travel to South Korea and start your journey.
